

AIDS 2022: Terms & conditions for delegates

Definitions

These terms & conditions for delegates are valid for every person registered as a delegate or student/postdoc/youth for AIDS 2022, the 24th International AIDS Conference (hereinafter referred to as "the conference" or "AIDS 2022"), which takes place in Montreal, Canada, and virtually from 29 July to 2 August 2022, with pre-conference meetings set to begin on 27 July 2022.

All references to the age of a person, mentioned in this and other conference documents, refer to the age of that person as of 27 July 2022, unless otherwise specified.

All references to a date or a deadline, mentioned in this and other AIDS 2022 documents, refer to the Central European Time Zone (CET).

The organizer of AIDS 2022 is IAS – the International AIDS Society – which is registered and based in Geneva, Switzerland.

Conference registration

Only fully completed registration forms will be accepted. The registration will only be confirmed upon receipt of payment in full. If the full payment has not been received before the respective fee deadline, the registration will be cancelled; it will then have to be re-submitted at the fee applicable at that time. If the maximum in-person delegate capacity is reached, the IAS reserves the right to decline new in-person plus virtual registrations, or requests to change from virtual registrations to in-person plus virtual registrations.

To be able to register as a delegate, individuals must be at least 16 years old. Delegates may be asked to present an official identity card stating their age. Persons under the age of 16 may attend together with a parent or guardian; see Accompanying person under the age of 16 for details.

To be able to register as a student/postdoc, individuals must be at least 16 years old and present proof of full-time enrolment at a recognized university or college at both the time of registration and during AIDS 2022.

To be able to register as a youth delegate, individuals must be between 16 and 25 (inclusive) years old and present proof of age (official identity card stating the age).

In-person plus virtual registration

The in-person plus virtual registration fee for delegates and students/postdocs/youths includes:

• In-person access to all conference sessions, satellite sessions, poster discussion sessions, the exhibition, the Global Village and pre-conference meetings.



 Online access to all conference sessions, satellite sessions and pre-conference meetings streamed live on the virtual platform, session recordings and other on-demand content, the virtual exhibition, e-posters and the virtual Global Village throughout the conference and after.

If the completed registration form, the payment in full and the required supporting documents (if applicable) are received on or before 1 June 2022, a printed pocket programme is guaranteed for in-person delegates. If the completed registration form and/or the full payment and/or the required supporting documents (if applicable) are received after 1 June 2022 (including onsite registrations), the IAS cannot guarantee that a printed pocket programme will be available. All pocket programmes will only be distributed onsite.

Virtual registration

The virtual registration includes online access to all conference sessions, satellite sessions and preconference meetings streamed live on the virtual platform, session recordings and other ondemand content, the virtual exhibition, e-posters and the virtual Global Village throughout the conference and after.

Accompanying person under the age of 16

To attend AIDS 2022 on their own delegates must be at least 16 years old.

Only delegates who are at least 18 years old are entitled to register an accompanying person under the age of 16.

In order to attend the in-person conference, individuals under the age of 16 (as of 27 July 2022) must be registered as accompanying person under the age of 16 and submit and bring a copy of the completed <u>parent/guardian consent form</u> to AIDS 2022.

Accompanying persons under the age of 16 must be with the registered regular delegate at all times when they are in the conference venue. The regular delegate they are accompanying will be held responsible for all actions of the accompanying person under the age of 16. In addition, accompanying persons under the age of 16 may be asked to provide official photo identification (for example, passport, student ID) confirming their age.

This registration fee for accompanying person under the age of 16 includes in-person access to all conference sessions, satellite sessions, poster discussion sessions, the exhibition, the Global Village and pre-conference meetings ONLY if they accompany the regular delegate to whom their registration is attached.

Invoice/registration confirmation

An invoice/registration confirmation will be sent by email once the AIDS 2022 Registration team has received the fully completed registration form, the related payment and any required supporting documents (if applicable). Delegates are requested to bring their invoice/registration confirmation to AIDS 2022 in order to receive their name badge onsite.

Methods of payment

The registration fee must accompany all conference registrations. Payments have to be made in advance and in USD only, using a credit card or by bank transfer (no cheques are accepted). All bank fees and money transfer costs must be prepaid by the transmitter. Clearly indicate AIDS 2022, participant number and the delegate's last name as a reference on all bank transfers.



Registration name change

A name change fee of USD65 will be charged for every name change to an existing registration. A new registration form for the substitute delegate should NOT be submitted. Name changes will be accepted by email and should indicate the old and new names and any changes in contact information. No name changes will be accepted after 15 July 2022.

Registration format change

AIDS 2022 allows you to change your registration to virtual or in-person plus virtual as follows:

- If there is a change from in-person plus virtual registration to virtual registration, the difference will be refunded free of charge until 1 June 2022. After this date, all refunds are subject to a USD 65 handling fee.
- If there is a change from virtual registration to in-person plus virtual registration, the difference will be charged.

Conference format change

Should the IAS change the conference format to fully virtual, all in-person plus virtual registrations will be converted to virtual registrations and the difference refunded.

Cancellation policy

Notification of cancellation must be made in writing and sent to the AIDS 2022 Registration team by email.

Refunds, if applicable, will be made in the same form as the original transaction. For original payments made by bank transfer, the cancellation notification or refund request must indicate all relevant information regarding the bank account to which a possible refund may be remitted. Credit will not be given for unattended events or early termination of attendance. Requests for refunds of any additional items ordered (such as the local charitable giving programme) will not be accepted.

If the written notification of cancellation (including all relevant information regarding the bank account, if applicable) is received on or before 1 June 2022, 50% of the registration fee will be refunded. No refund requests will be accepted after 1 June 2022. The cancellation will not be effective until a written acknowledgement from the AIDS 2022 Registration team is received.

In the case of overpayment or double payment, refund requests (including all relevant information regarding the bank account and any required supporting documents, if applicable) must be made in writing and sent to the AIDS 2022 Registration team, by email, no later than 2 August 2022. A handling fee of USD65 will be charged. No refund requests will be accepted after 2 August 2022. The refund will not be effective until a written acknowledgement from the AIDS 2022 Registration team is received.

Cancellation of AIDS 2022

If AIDS 2022 cannot be held or is postponed due to events beyond the control of the IAS (including force majeure) or due to events that are not attributable to wrongful intent or gross negligence of



the IAS, the IAS cannot be held liable by delegates for any damages, costs, financial losses or any other losses incurred.

Under these circumstances, the IAS reserves the right to either retain the entire registration fee and use it for a future conference or to reimburse the delegate after deducting costs already incurred for the organization of AIDS 2022 and which could not be recovered from third parties.

Modification of the programme

The IAS reserves the right to modify the programme, which is published as an indication only.

Lost name badge

The conference name badge must be worn at all times during the in-person conference. Access to the conference venue will not be granted without a proper name badge. If a delegate loses, misplaces or forgets the name badge, a handling fee of USD65 will be charged for a new name badge. Upon handing out a new name badge, the lost badge will be deactivated and become invalid.

Letter of invitation

Individuals requiring an official letter of invitation from the IAS can request one through the online registration form. To receive a letter of invitation, delegates must first register for AIDS 2022, pay in full and submit any required supporting documentation (if applicable).

This letter of invitation does not place any financial obligations on the IAS. All expenses incurred in relation to conference participation are the sole responsibility of the conference delegate. The letter of invitation does not guarantee an entry visa to Canada.

Visa requirements

It is the sole responsibility of the delegate to confirm any <u>visa requirements</u>. Delegates who require an entry visa must allow sufficient time for the application procedure. Delegates should contact the nearest Canadian embassy or consulate to determine the appropriate timing of their visa applications. We strongly encourage delegates to submit their visa applications to the authorities as early as possible and at least 12 weeks before the travel date.

Delegate registration details may be shared with the Canadian immigration authorities to assist in the immigration process. However, the IAS and/or the AIDS 2022 Registration team will not directly contact embassies and consulates on behalf of delegates.

If a visa was applied for in time (that is before 5 May 2022 for AIDS 2022 delegates) and proof is shown that a visa was not granted even though all requested documents were submitted, the inperson plus virtual registration will be converted to a virtual registration and the difference refunded. A refund for any additional items ordered cannot be made. Refund requests must be made in writing and sent with the required proof to the AIDS 2022 Registration team, by email, no later than 2 August 2022. No refund requests (including required proofs) will be accepted after this date.



Data protection and sharing of contact details with third parties

The IAS will collect, process, transfer and store delegates' personal data only for: (i) the preparation and execution of AIDS 2022; and (ii) the preparation of future International AIDS Society, AIDS and HIVR4P conferences. Data protection is warranted in accordance with the Swiss Data Protection Act. Delegates' personal data will be retained securely and only be accessible on a need-to-know basis by duly authorized persons. For further information please read the IAS data privacy policy.

The data of delegates registering for AIDS 2022 entered in the conference account – that is, full first and last name(s), date of birth, email, country of residence, nationality, healthcare professional status, gender, organization, profession – will be shared with the following entity (third party) in countries where legislation might not ensure an adequate level of data protection:

- AIDS 2022 Registration team, c/o K.I.T. Group, Germany
- AIDS 2022 virtual platform provider

In order to facilitate border entry and visa applications, delegate data included in your letter of invitation (first and last name, home address, date of birth, passport number, nationality) may also be shared with the Canadian immigration authorities.

The contact details (full name and home address, participant type, email, healthcare professional status) of delegates who have agreed to share their contact details when registering will be shared periodically with the following conference sponsors in countries where legislation might not ensure an adequate level of data protection:

- Janssen Global Services, LLC, USA

The above-mentioned conference sponsors may only use these contact details to contact delegates regarding activities during AIDS 2022 or other communications which may be of related interest. Therefore, data might be passed on to third parties unless otherwise explicitly indicated by the delegate on the registration form.

The delegates herewith authorize the IAS to collect, process and transfer their personal data to the above-listed third parties and authorities. The delegates further expressly acknowledge and agree that any personal data disclosed in connection with the conference account and registration form will be subject to the laws of the country where it is transferred and may not be covered by Swiss law. The IAS cannot assure delegates that the laws and regulations in the recipient country will necessarily offer the same level of confidentiality or data protection as under Swiss law and may require the above-listed third parties and/or authorities to whom the personal data is transferred to disclose all or any part of the personal data to other authorities or third parties.

The IAS will nevertheless contractually ensure that delegates' personal data will be processed by the above-listed third parties to the same extent as it is authorized for itself under Swiss law. The IAS will also ensure that all third parties that will process delegates' personal data have implemented appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect delegates' personal data against accidental or unlawful destruction or accidental loss, alteration, unauthorized



disclosure or access, and which provide a level of security appropriate to the risk represented by the processing and the nature of the data to be protected.

K.I.T. Group will collect and store all personal data for the preparation and execution of AIDS 2022 and not use the personal data for any other purposes.

During the registration process and the execution of the Conference the personal data of each attendee is processed. All personal data will be processed in accordance with the applicable data protection regulations, in particular the General Data Protection Regulation GDPR (Regulation (EU) 2016/679) and the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG).

Personal data will not be forwarded to a third party unless in accordance with Art. 6 Sec. 1 lit a-f GDPR: (a) express consent, (b) performance or conclusion of a contract, (c) fulfilment of a legal obligation, (d) protection of vital interests of the data subject or another natural person, (e) public interest or exercise of official authority, (f) legitimate interest of the data controller and balancing of interests.

In the course of participation in the conference, personal data may be processed by companies based in third countries outside the European Union. The attendee consents to such data processing insofar as it is necessary for his participation and the full use of the conference services.

Conference embargo policy

All AIDS 2022 abstracts are released to delegates and media under a strict embargo policy. A detailed breakdown of embargo procedures for different types of abstracts is available on the AIDS 2022 conference embargo policy page.

All conference participants, presenters and media commit to adhere to this policy when they apply for conference registration.

Photo and video consent

In view of the fact that the events related to AIDS 2022 will be filmed and photographed, you hereby agree that, by attending the conference, your image and/or voice may be recorded and published or broadcasted through different media.

IAS principles and values of conference participation

By attending AIDS 2022, delegates agree to comply with the <u>IAS principles and values of conference</u> <u>participation</u>.

Liability

The IAS shall be held liable in the framework of a duty of care as a respectable business according to statutory provisions. The liability of the IAS – for whatever legal reason – shall be limited to intent and gross negligence. The liability of commissioned service providers shall remain unaffected by



this. The delegate shall take part in AIDS 2022 at their own risk. Oral agreements shall not be binding if these have not been confirmed in writing by the IAS.

Fulfilment and jurisdiction

These terms & conditions for delegates and the rights of the parties hereunder shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Switzerland, without regard to choice of law rules.

Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of, or in relation to, these terms & conditions for delegates shall be resolved by arbitration in accordance with the Swiss Rules of International Arbitration of the Swiss Chambers' Arbitration Institution in force on the date on which the notice of arbitration is submitted in accordance with these rules. The number of arbitrators shall be one. The seat of the arbitration shall be Geneva. The arbitral proceedings shall be conducted in English. The arbitration shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions for expedited procedure.
