An activist since 2005, she co-founded and became the inaugural Executive Director of Gender DynamiX, the first South African-and African-registered organization focusing on trans advocacy (2005-2014). Liesl was the consultant for the International Trans Fund, supporting its establishment. As a consultant, she has also provided logistical support to the Global Philanthropy Project and strategic planning for ECADE in the Caribbean and S.H.E. in South Africa.

Liesl produced the report, *Over-policed, Under-protected: Experiences of Trans and Gender Diverse Communities in the*

Caribbean, for OutRight Action International and UCTRANS in 2021. She worked with GATE, developing technical briefs and a toolkit, *SDGs and Trans engagement*, as well as a toolkit for GATE and GNP+, *How to do HIV Advocacy Planning*.

Liesl lives in Mexico City and has expanded her consultation work within the Caribbean region. She enjoys walking in the city and taking photos of street murals and graffiti, especially those with quirky, political or resistance messages.
